**IMPORTANT INFORMATION**

RE: Sewer Line Maintenance  
KW – 2023 Green Streets Phase II (Construction of New Storm Sewer)

Dear RESIDENT,


The Village remains on track for commencing an improvement project to your street in 2022. The work will involve installation of a new storm sewer system and a porous paver roadway. To prepare for the project, we examined video of the residential sanitary sewer lines taken last year by utility contractors. We have already contacted homeowners where we observed failed or damaged sewer lines. We did not observe damage to your sanitary line, but it does appear that your sewer service could benefit from a cleaning due to observed debris. If you decide to have a plumber clean/flush your line, you may also wish to consider having the line televised again to determine the overall condition of your sanitary sewer line.

We are bringing our findings to your attention because the condition of your sanitary sewer line is often a forgotten about element of home ownership. We are not requiring you to take any action. However, in an effort to help you obtain the best possible pricing for sewer maintenance, the Village has contacted several area contractors with a request for volume pricing. While we are not recommending a contractor, the following have indicated a willingness to offer discounts if they are able to secure several projects in your neighborhood.
