General Information

Beach Season: Memorial Day weekend (May 24th) - Labor Day (September 1st)

Lifeguards On-Site: Daily 10:00 AM – 6:00 PM

Beach Closures: The Beach may close due to inclement weather, hazardous swimming conditions, or reasons that may pose safety issues. Rules and Regulations

These rules and regulations are intended to promote the safety, comfort, and enjoyment of those using the beach during the beach season. Nonconformance by a few will result in the annoyance or discomfort to others and should be avoided. Therefore, the beach staff have been instructed to enforce these rules uniformly without exception.

- If the Beach Manager or the Village determines the water is too cold or rough for swimming, a red flag shall be displayed and the beach will be officially closed while such conditions continue. Persons who go into the water at this time do so at their own peril.
- Breakwater Safety Precautions
 - Access on to breakwater structures is expressly prohibited, including but not limited to climbing, walking, sunbathing, sitting, and playing on or near the structures.
 - Do not jump, dive off, or swim near structures.
 - Hanging onto structures while swimming is expressly prohibited.
- Lifeguard protection is limited to the immediate vicinity of the South (Swimming) Beach. Patrons must stay within the designated swimming area. Lifeguards will warn patrons when they have gone too far.
- A pre-determined swim zone is set prior to season opening. Patrons are asked to not swim further than the swim zone identified by buoys.
- No person shall appear in a state of nudity, or shall any person make any indecent exposure of any kind on the beach or in the water.
- Children under 8 must be accompanied by an adult at all times.
- Profane, offensive or vulgar language will not be tolerated.
- No dogs are allowed on the beach.
- Rough, boisterous, or offensive activity will not be tolerated.
- Ball playing on the beach will be stopped when it causes annoyance to other beach patrons.
- No littering.
- Glass and alcoholic beverages are prohibited.
- Fires and incendiary devices are prohibited.
- No soliciting.
- No boats, rafts, or floats within 300 feet of the beach.
- If patrons appear to be ill or have skin lesions, beach staff will not allow the patron to go into the water.

Season Pass Guidelines

You may purchase a season pass online or in-person at Village Hall, Monday through Friday from 8:30 AM to 5:00 PM. Beach pass application forms can be found at www.vok.org.

The season pass is a card with each individual’s name that can only be used by the person to whom it has been issued. Passes are not transferable.

Beach patrons must provide issued beach passes to access the beach. Photos of beach passes will not be accepted.

All family members aged 3 and older must have their own beach pass. Children ages 2 and under are free.

Season pass refunds are not given for any reason after Opening Day.

BEACH REGISTRATION

Beach passes are available for purchase starting May 1st. Please return your completed beach application to Village Hall or purchase them online to receive your beach pass. Beach passes must be presented to the Admissions Clerk on duty upon entrance to the beach. Access will NOT be permitted without a season pass. Replacement fee for a lost or stolen season beach pass is \$5.
